



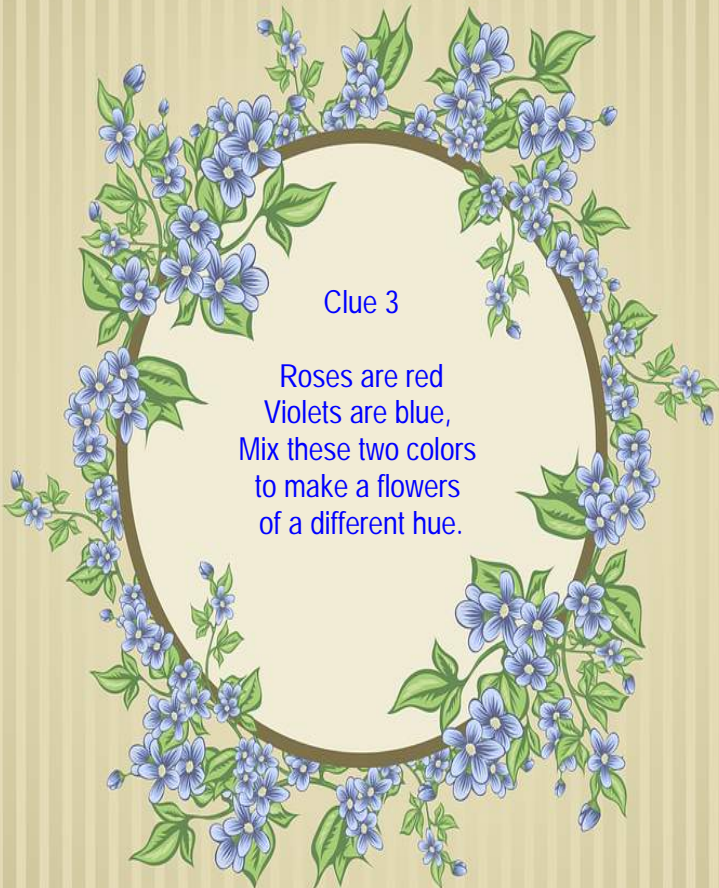
Clue 1

 Squares eight times eight the battlefield.


The castle walls protect our backs

 to squares eight times eight the battlefield.




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Clue 5

A clue that will lead you straight.

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
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Clue 7

 What you seek you will find in a sort of flask.



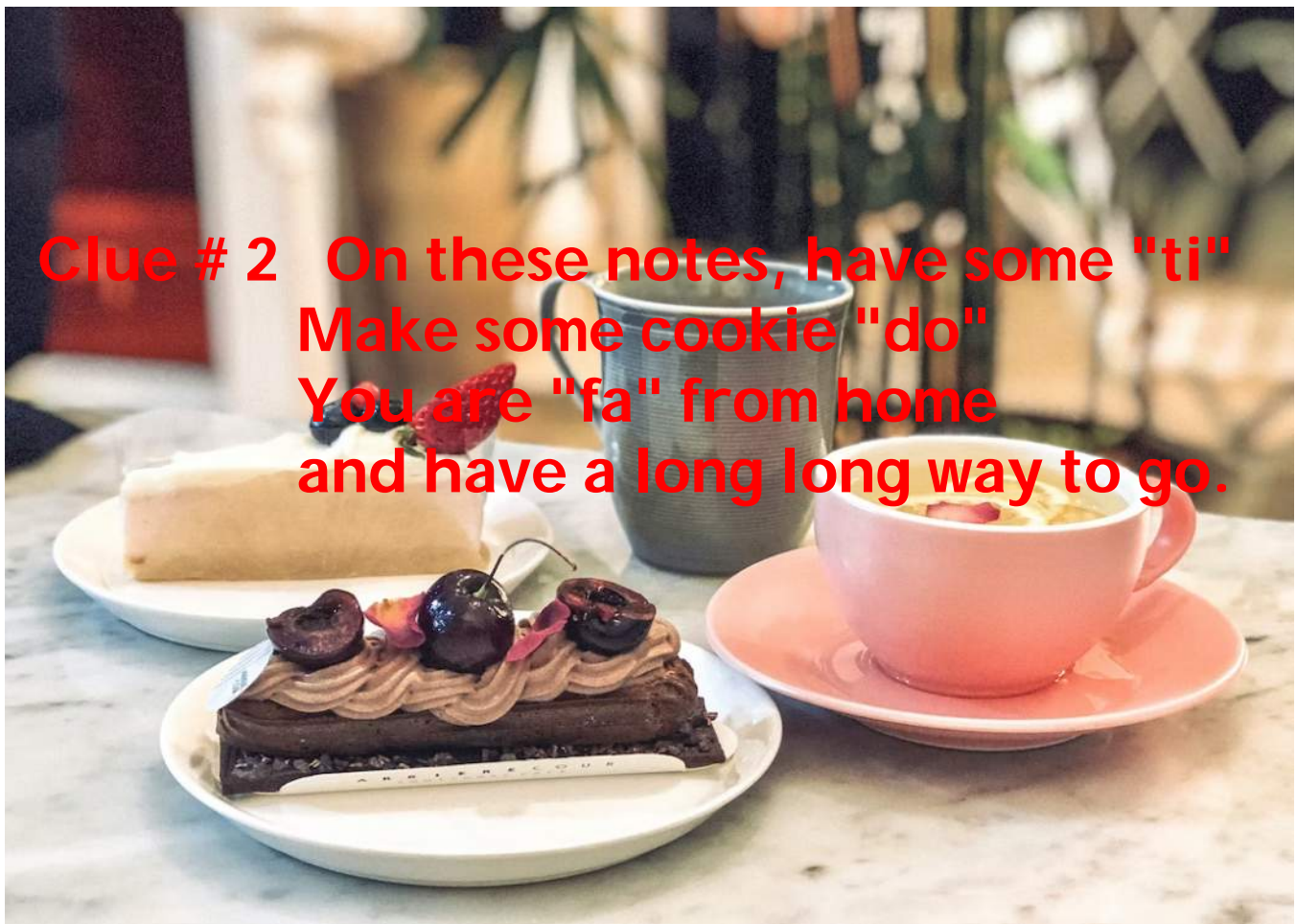
Clue #10

 Your next clue is hidden out of sight.

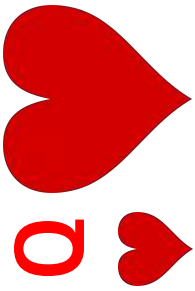

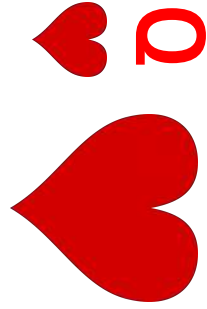
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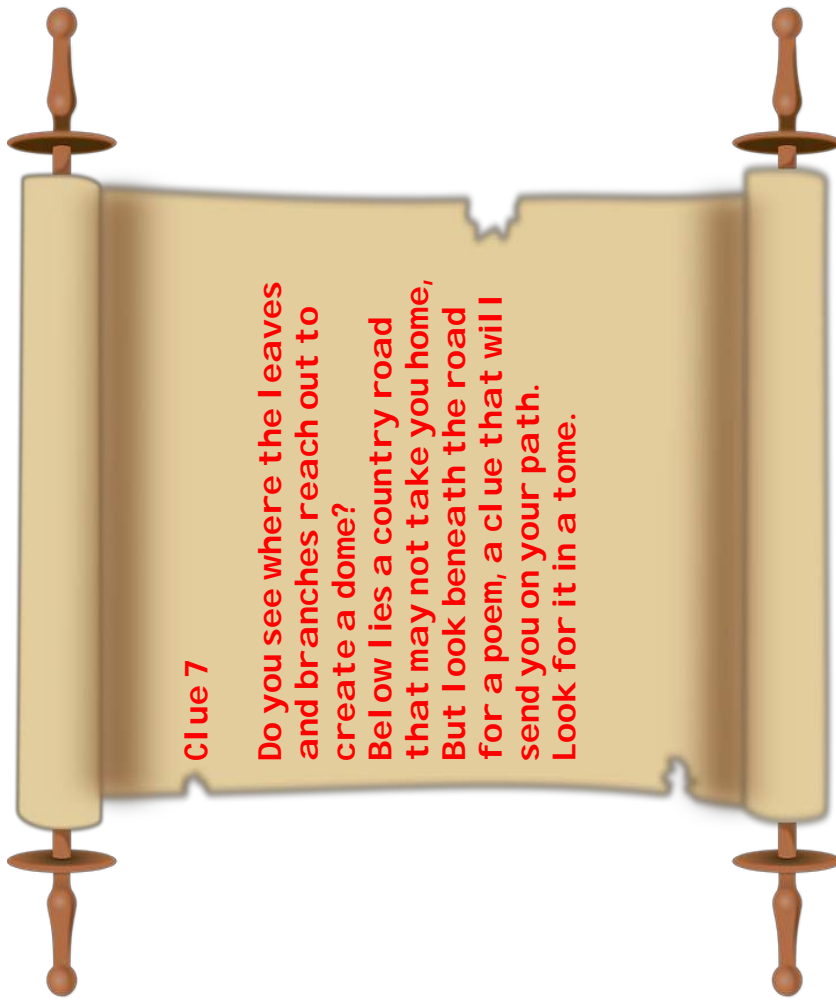
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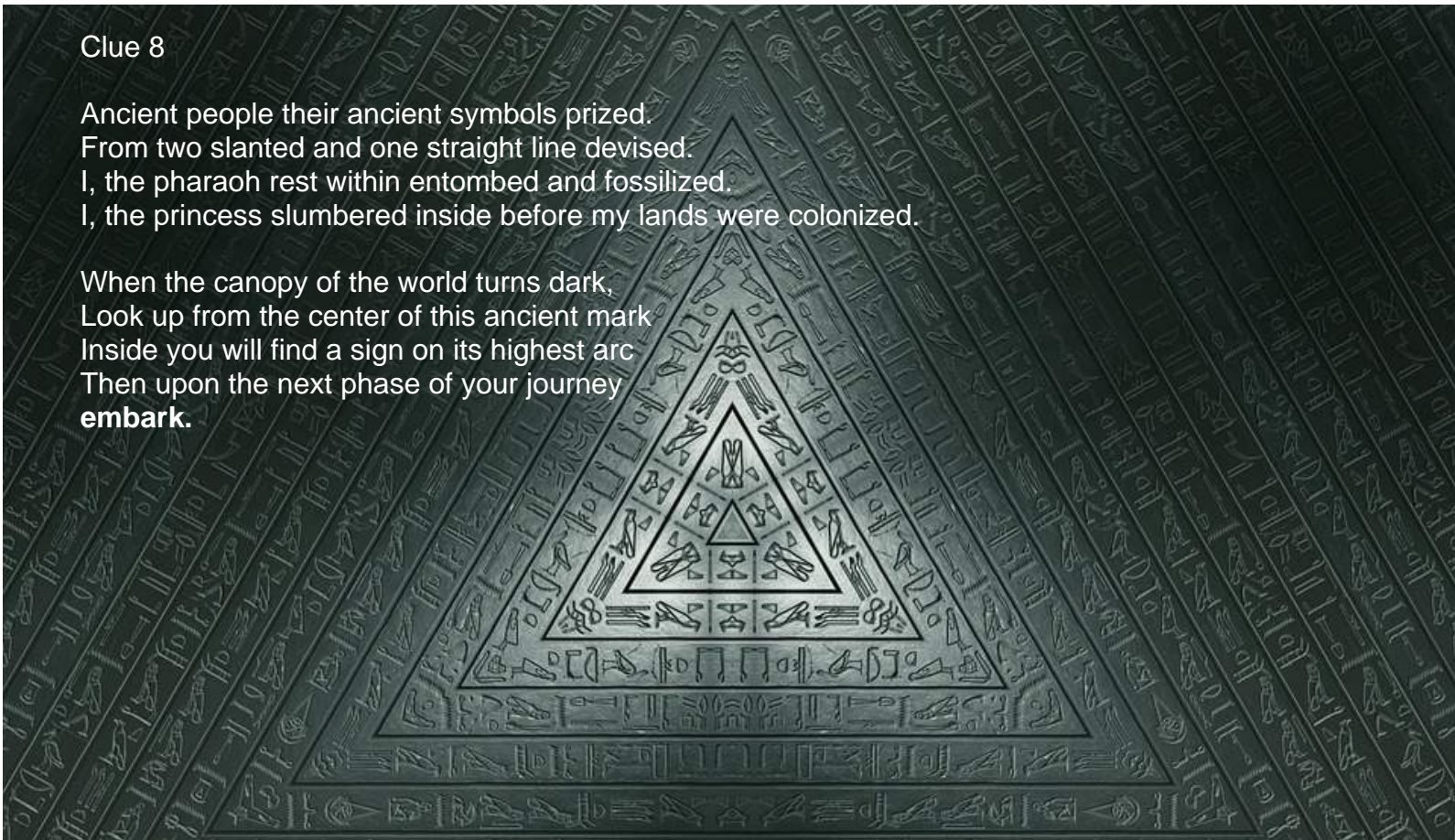
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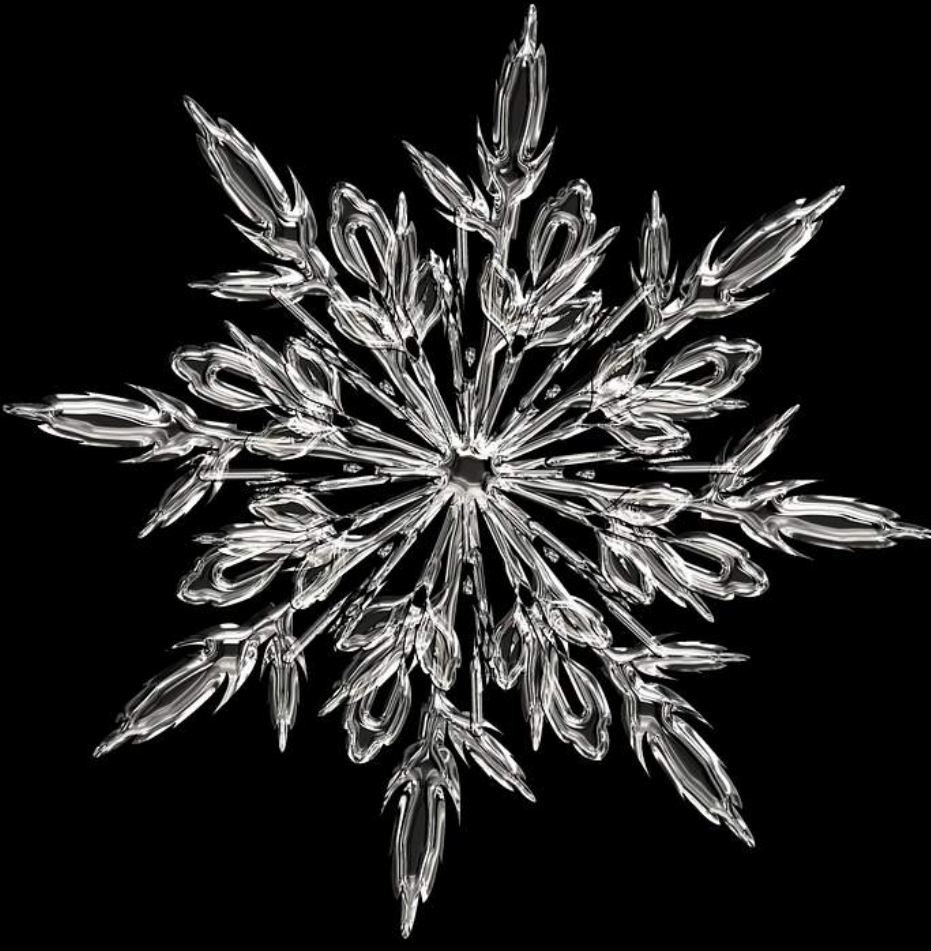
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Clue 11
